RO PLASTIC-MASTER'S PIECES

calling artists to reuse and reinvent plastic waste

Massimiliano Adami / Meteora

Light sculpture composed of a body made of polyurethane foam with drowned re-used plastic objects. Sectioning transforms some of the objects into places where fluorescent or led light sources can be inserted while some other are elongated to the ground, becoming supports. The electric power is supplied from a cable connected to a multiple socket drowned in the foam body.

Materials:

Colored plastic objects of different types, colored polyurethane foam with iridescent pigments.
Fluorescent lights, LED lights and lantern with fixed light battery powered

Dimension:

diameter ca. 130 cm., height 170/190 cm

Massimiliano Adami designs and manufactures objects pioneering the use of materials and he intervenes systematically on construction techniques to achieve unprecedented aesthetic and functional solutions. His pieces are part in important international design galleries and shown in many expositions. He has realized experimental projects for some furnishing companies.
